#### **From President Desk**

Chhattisgarh Agricon Samiti began its journey with a vision to develop entrepreneurial skill among farmers through integration of natural resources. With a humble start from 2007-2008, the organisation got a good penetration, among rural masses of Chhattisgarh. The organisation has a single directional Mission to develop income generating opportunities at village level through integration of natural resources, Initiation to promote and strengthen livelihoods of rural masses from grass root level, is the work focus. Women are aimed to be central feature to the project interventions.

Under economy development programmes, Organisation took up Wadi Development Projects Sponsored by NABARD under Tribal Development Fund. Wadi Development Projects, and Pithora I & 2 (Distr. Mahasammund), Baster 1 & 2 (District Bastar) and kota (District Bilaspur). Out of these 5Projects, 3 Projects i.e. Pithora I, Bastar I & Bilaspur have completed their tenure by F.Y. 2017.Organisation did serve the rural mass.

Simultaneously Chhattisgarh Agricon Samiti has taken up two projects of watershed programmes in district Bilaspur. Watershed programme has a national significance.

Chhattisgarh Agricon Samiti has undertaken, implementation of strategic programme (under MOU with the Panchayat and Rural Development Department of CG). designed as "Project for convergence of MGNREGA, NRLM & CFT Strategy" Organization is privileged to be associated with "The largest and most ambitions social security & public work programme in the world.



Under the project we conducted base-line Survey to know whether various provisions of MGNREGA Act are being implemented properly for the desired impact. CFT worked as secretarial for more than 300 GP and assisted them to create good quality. Assets, Village planning based on approached and Monday generation

We successfully implemented CFT Projects in: -

- Chhura, Block (District Gariyaband)
- 2. Fingeshwar, Block (District Gariyaband)
- 3. Magarlod, Block (District Dhamtari)
- 4. Bastanar, Block (District Baster)
- 5. Lohandiguda, Block (District Baster)

CG Agricon has now also started its operation in North of C.G. Kusumi Block, Distt. Balrampur under CFT MGNREGS NRLM Project. Up till now presence of Samiti was confined to South & Central C.G.

Chhattisgarh Agricon Samiti opted for SHPI and proposed to NABARD for the formation of 500 SHGs in Kota, Block Bilaspur District in Jan 2015. Grant assistance from NABARD has been sanctioned in Oct 2015

Concluding the aforesaid development programme executed by us in the year 2016-17. I feel honored to present his Annual Report and to be part of such massive development movement all around.

I also take this as an opportunity to thanks all of my colleagues, Co-workers and who assisted from behind for their valuable contributions and enthusiasm.

Obviously postal address is changed. We applied for revalidation of heas address to Registrar & firms & Societies to which R.F.S. agreed and accorded acceptance vide No. 624 dated 10.06.2016

#### **Future Plan**

Chhattisgarh Agricon Samiti nurtures its ambition to serve the rural community in a better & efficient way and scale, it deserves financial funding from foreign agencies. It needs F.C.R.A. clearance, Organisation plans to apply for F.C.R.A. Simultaneously relief under 80G shall be needed for which Income Tax Deptt. is to be requested. We shall move for it early. Since organization has fine interaction with tribal communities, it can carry out the welfare schemes sponsored by Tribal Development Deptt. Chhattisgarh Agricon Samiti plans to contact with T.D. Deptt.

Organistaion, has enough strength as technical persons, it plans to create an infrastructure to arrange trainings on latest technologies of Agriculture, Horticulture, on organic farming, handicrafts and other livelihood activities. Organization proposes to establish a valuable training center.

Chhattisgarh Agricon Samiti also proposes to acquire G.I.S. based expertise which will be helps in big way.



#### Work is in Progress.

Chhattisgarh Agricon Samiti under took a prestigious work translation of Resource Book by MoRD on MGNREGA from English to Hindi. Organisation is accredited for Hindi edition, Which is being circulated in Hindi speaking States, TOR has been offered by GIZ (German Development Co-operation) on behalf of MoRD.

On Instance of NABARD we have taken up the formation of Farmer Producer Organisation, which will collectivise the wadi farmers to adopt latest technology, enchanting productivity and proper marketing.

#### Governance

The supreme body to look in to the transparent governance viz decisions taking, budget formation & resources creation, implementability of the project, Control over finance, administration and human resource is "EXCUTIVE COMMITTEE".

Executive Committee is democratically elected body and its tenure space is 3 Financial Year.

#### **Human Resource Policy**

It Contains Employment, placement, assignments and accordingly delegation of power which also decides emoluments Service & Leave conditions, transfer and dismissal.

#### **Executive Committee**

Executive Committee, also bear the Eespauselileties responsibility constitutional, local laws, interpretations on doubts, arbitration, and convergence with Govt. or any other agencies. It is also responsible for creation, and maintenance of assets.




