Why invest in Youth Agri - Entrepreneurship Program

In rural Kabirdham, youth are leaving the land — not because they want to, but because they see no future in it.

With farming viewed as low-income, low-dignity, and low-innovation:

Youth unemployment is rising

Migration to cities for insecure jobs is becoming the norm

Traditional knowledge and rural resilience are eroding fast

Meanwhile, there's untapped opportunity in value-added farming, Agri-processing, bio-enterprises, and rural tech — but no support ecosystem to help youth tap into it.

What Are We Proposing?

We propose the Youth Agri-Entrepreneurship Program — a year-round, village-based support system that helps rural youth build, test, and grow businesses within their own communities.

Key Components:

Village-Level Bootcamps & Idea Labs

- Mobilize and screen youth (18–30) interested in farming and enterprise
- Use participatory methods to identify business ideas rooted in local resources

Mentorship Hubs

- Build district-level training modules on:
 - 1. Enterprise planning
 - 2. Marketing & pricing
 - 3. Financial literacy
 - 4. Digital tools (QR codes, WhatsApp biz, Kisan apps)
 - Pair youth with mentors (local entrepreneurs, FPO leaders, NGOs)

Seed Grants & Starter Kits

- Support ~10
 youth with small
 capital grants,
 raw materials, or
 basic
 infrastructure
- Examples: nursery kits, mushroom units, bio-input starter packs, drying/storage tools

Market Linkage & Branding Support

 Help these entrepreneurs access FPOs, SHGs, haats, or online platforms

Digital Showcasing & Peer Learning

- Document each entrepreneur's journey
- Create a local "Role Model Network" to inspire others

Why Kabirdham?

- 60% of Kabirdham's population is under 30 most stuck in low-paying agriculture or outmigration cycles
- Traditional knowledge exists but innovation and capital are missing
- Under the ongoing program, the district now has skilled youth, established laboratories, FPOs, and a strong volunteer base — creating the perfect foundation to anchor youth into agri-entrepreneurship.
